What is Mediation?



If you are going through any family law action, you will probably hear the word mediation thrown around quite a bit. Most people understand the concept of the word, but what does mediation really involve?

At the most basic level, mediation is when you and your spouse (and your attorneys) meet with a neutral third party who facilitates both parties coming to a settlement agreement. While a mediator does not give legal advice to either party (that's what your attorney

is for, and they should be present), the mediator will help improve your communication with your spouse regarding the contentious issues that haven't been agreed upon.

The benefits of the mediator is that is can be much cheaper route than going to a hearing or trial, it is strictly confidential, allows you both to come to agreement based on what you think is fair given your situation, and most importantly, you and your spouse have control over the process versus ultimately having a judge make decisions for you.

The process is very informal, does not involve the judge ae, and can often result in all issues being resolved and agreed upon without ever going to court. Mediation is a great option that most couples should consider before moving on to more costly strategies with your attorney.

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

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
